Aeroplan Announces 2011 Mile Matching Days

Aeroplan to Match Donations to its Beyond Miles Partners on Day of their choice

MONTREAL, April 27 /CNW Telbec/ - Aeroplan today announced that it will match all miles donated by members to each of its nine Beyond Miles charitable partners as part of the 2011 Aeroplan Match Days. Miles will be matched on a 1 for 1 basis up to 1.5 million Aeroplan Miles for each partner organization. Each organization has chosen its own match day and Aeroplan will match miles for a 24-hour period.

Since the program was launched in 2006, more than 200 million Aeroplan Miles have been donated by members. Beyond Miles partners use Aeroplan Miles to offset costs related to travel by air as well as hotel accommodations and car rentals. Aeroplan offsets 100 per cent of all carbon emissions from flights taken by Beyond Miles partners using donated miles. In 2011, Aeroplan donated 1.25 million miles to each of its partner organizations. Aeroplan also announced recently that members can now automatically donate 2 per cent of all miles accumulated to any Beyond Miles partner of the member's choice. In addition, Aeroplan also has a Charitable Pooling program that allows members to use miles to support individuals, families or local grass roots charities in need. Members have pooled more than 57 million miles into over 430 pooling accounts across the country.
