Media Advisory - Air Canada Participates in Recognition Event Marking Introduction of Biojet Fuel at Toronto-Pearson International Airport

MONTREAL, April 17, 2018 /CNW Telbec/ - Air Canada will participate in a recognition eventThursday, April 19, 2018 hosted by the Canadian Biofuel Supply Chain Initiative (CBSCI) to mark the introduction of biojet fuels into Toronto Pearson International Airport's shared fuel system.
