## Air Canada Employees and Air Canada Foundation Rally for Lebanon

In August 2020, an explosion struck Lebanon's capital of Beirut in a catastrophe that deepened an already existing humanitarian crisis amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. The explosion left thousands in need, with tensions rising due to political and financial instability.

Jumping quickly into action, many Air Canada employees banded together to generously raise donations for the Lebanon Humanitarian Needs Appeal, an initiative launched by the Canadian Red Cross, a humanitarian partner of Air Canada.
