Air Canada Announces Appointment of Derek Vanstone as Vice President, Corporate Strategy, Industry and Government Affairs

Mr. Vanstone will report directly to Calin Rovinescu, President and Chief Executive Officer. Mr. Vanstone will assume the strategy, government and industry affairs portfolio held by Duncan Dee, Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer who is taking early retirement. An announcement on a successor for the Chief Operating Officer role will be made in the near future.
