

Air Canada to launch service to Red Deer, AB connecting Central Alberta to international network

MONTREAL, July 10, 2013 /CNW Telbec/ - Air Canada announced today it will commence scheduled service to Red Deer, Alberta on September 3, 2013 with three daily flights from Red Deer Airport to Calgary. Flights will be operated by Air Georgian under the Air Canada Express brand, using 18-seat Beechcraft 1900D aircraft.
