Air Canada employees, retirees participate in vintage aircraft flyover in France

Current and retired Air Canada employees will be participating in the flypast on April 9, with four of the five participating vintage aircraft flown by retired or active Air Canada pilots. - increasing capacity to France to accommodate those wishing to travel to the event.
