The new Navigator app delivers up to the minute information about flights and enables passengers to make informed travel choices. The new app includes:

- Flight Status real time flight status updates with departure and arrivals information and map view
- Flight Schedule Search search for flights right across the Star Alliance member airline network
- Airport Information comprehensive information including maps
- Lounges location and facilities of the more than 970 lounges which eligible Star Alliance customers can access across the globe
- City Guides where to stay, eat, drink, shop, etc.

The app is the Alliance's first on the iPhone and is currently available in English as a free download from www.staralliance.com/en/services/apps/iphone/ or from the Apple App store. Further language versions and operating systems are due to be released in the foreseeable future.
