## Air Canada inaugurates daily flights between Ottawa and Iqaluit with same plane service to/from Montréal

MONTREAL, March 28 /CNW Telbec/ - Today marks the expansion of Air Canada's network to its most northern destination with the start up of daily non-stop service to Iqaluit, Nunavut from Ottawa with same-plane service to/from Montréal.
