## Air Canada's Ontario and Quebec passes return to offer unlimited flying this summer for only \$1,099

The Ontario Pass is not valid for point-to-point travel between Toronto and Ottawa (connections involving these two cities are permitted). The Quebec Pass does not permit travel to or from Iles de la Madeleine. Pass prices include the fuel surcharge and all other fees and surcharge except G.S.T. and Q.S.T where applicable.
