

Travel advisory for flights to / from Toronto

MONTREAL, Feb. 29 /CNW Telbec/ - Air Canada and Air Canada Jazz advise that forecasted winter storm conditions combined with runway configuration and airport ground delay programs at Toronto Pearson airport are expected to cause some delays and cancellations to flights during the rest of the day Friday, February 29, 2008.

Customers with flights to or from Toronto are advised to check on the status of their flight prior to leaving for the airport online at aircanada.com
